Baclofen Dosing Guidance

Goals of Therapy¹

- Improve functional movement & gait
- Improve range of motion & prevent contractures
- Reduce pain & spasms
- Improve seating & posture

Anticipated Responders

Generalized spasticity²

Preparation


- Regular release tablets: 10, 20 mg
- Recipe available for
 5 mg/mL oral suspension

Side Effects/Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs)

- Drowsiness, dizziness
- Sedation, somnolence
- Hypotonia, weakness
- Cognitive function impairment
- Ataxia
- Hypotension

Withdrawal Symptoms

- Increased spasticity
- Hallucinations
- Confusion
- Hyperthermia
- Seizures



Dosing

- Consider modified dosing in obese patients
- Absolute max doses:

<2 yrs: 40 mg daily

2 - 7 yrs: 60 mg daily ≥ 8 yrs: 80 mg daily

Follow up

- Adverse drug reactions
- Remind caregivers of withdrawal symptoms
- Caregiver perceived changes in patient range of motion in affected joints
- CP CHILD
- CP QoL (Child or Teen)
- Posture & mobility
- Pain control

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
